

1 Amend printed bill, page 15, after line 20 insert:

2 **"SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 12-315-127 as
3 follows:

4 **12-315-127. Veterinary drug donation program - rules.** (1) AN
5 OWNER OF AN ANIMAL MAY DONATE A DRUG THAT IS DISPENSED FOR BUT
6 NOT USED BY THE ANIMAL TO A LICENSED VETERINARIAN OR ANIMAL
7 SHELTER IN WHICH VETERINARY MEDICINE IS PRACTICED IF THE LICENSED
8 VETERINARIAN OR ANIMAL SHELTER ACCEPTS THE DRUG.

9 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4)(b) OF THIS SECTION,
10 A LICENSED VETERINARIAN MAY REISSUE A DONATED DRUG ACCEPTED
11 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION TO FILL OTHER PRESCRIPTIONS DISPENSED BY
12 THE LICENSED VETERINARIAN FREE OF CHARGE FOR AN ANIMAL IF:

13 (a) THE LICENSED VETERINARIAN DETERMINES THAT THE OWNER
14 OF THE ANIMAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE REISSUANCE OF THE DRUG BASED ON
15 ECONOMIC NEED;

16 (b) THE LICENSED VETERINARIAN DETERMINES THAT THE DRUG IS
17 SUITABLE FOR REISSUANCE;

18 (c) THE DRUG WAS ORIGINALLY DISPENSED BY A LICENSED
19 VETERINARIAN;

20 (d) THE DRUG IS NOT A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE;

21 (e) THE DRUG IS NOT A COMPOUNDED DRUG;

22 (f) THE DRUG DOES NOT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION BEFORE OPENING
23 AND THE DRUG WAS UNOPENED WHEN DONATED;

24 (g) THE DRUG IS NOT IN A LIQUID FORM OR, IF IN LIQUID FORM, THE
25 DRUG IS PACKAGED IN A SINGLE DOSE IN AN AMPULE OR VIAL;

26 (h) THE DRUG HAS NOT EXPIRED;

27 (i) THE PACKAGING OR BOTTLE CONTAINS THE EXPIRATION DATE
28 OF THE DRUG; AND

29 (j) THE NAME OF THE ANIMAL AND THE NAME OF THE OWNER OF
30 THE ANIMAL FOR WHICH THE DRUG WAS ORIGINALLY DISPENSED, THE
31 PRESCRIPTION NUMBER, AND ANY OTHER IDENTIFYING MARKS ARE
32 OBLITERATED FROM THE PACKAGING OR BOTTLE BEFORE THE DRUG IS
33 REISSUED.

34 (3) A LICENSED VETERINARIAN SHALL:

35 (a) IDENTIFY AND MAINTAIN SEPARATELY FROM OTHER STOCK A
36 DONATED DRUG ACCEPTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION; AND

37 (b) MAKE A RECORD OF EACH DONATED DRUG ACCEPTED
38 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION THAT INCLUDES, AT A MINIMUM:

39 (A) THE DATE ON WHICH THE DRUG WAS DONATED;

- (B) THE NAME OF THE PERSON WHO DONATED THE DRUG; AND
- (C) THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE DRUG.

(4) A LICENSED VETERINARIAN SHALL NOT:

(a) SELL OR RESELL A DONA

(b) DISRE

(b) DISPENSE A DONATED DRUG ACCEPTED PURSUANT TO THIS
ON TO FILL OTHER PRESCRIPTIONS DISPENSED BY THE LICENSED
LINARIAN FOR AN ANIMAL IF THE ANIMAL IS RAISED TO PRODUCE
FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION OR THE ANIMAL IS ORDINARILY
UMED BY ANIMALS THAT ARE RAISED TO PRODUCE FOOD FOR HUMAN
CONSUMPTION.

26 (6) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT RULES AS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT
27 THIS SECTION, INCLUDING:

28 (a) REQUIREMENTS FOR REISSUING DONATED DRUGS PURSUANT TO
29 THIS SECTION, INCLUDING REQUIREMENTS THAT PROVIDE APPROPRIATE
30 SAFEGUARDS FOR ENSURING THAT THE DRUGS ARE NOT COMPROMISED OR
31 ILLEGALLY DIVERTED BEFORE BEING REISSUED;

32 (b) REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTING DRUGS DONATED BY A
33 LICENSED VETERINARIAN OR ANIMAL SHELTER; AND

34 (c) REQUIREMENTS FOR MAINTAINING RECORDS RELATING TO THE
35 ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF DONATED DRUGS TO FILL OTHER PRESCRIPTIONS
36 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.".
