Committee on Judiciary.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB26-1255 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, line 8, strike "SECTION," and substitute
2 "SECTION OR ANY OTHER LAW, INCLUDING SECTION 32 OF ARTICLE II OF
3 THE STATE CONSTITUTION; THE "COLORADO PRIVACY ACT", PART 13 OF
4 ARTICLE 1 OF TITLE 6; SECTION 16-3-301 (4); AND THE "REPRODUCTIVE
5 HEALTH EQUITY ACT", PART 4 OF ARTICLE 6 OF TITLE 25,".

6 Page 5, lines 16 and 17, strike "**threats and enticements**" and substitute
7 "**adverse actions**".

8 Page 5, after line 19 insert:

9 "(a) "ADVERSE ACTION" MEANS AN ACTION TAKEN BY A SOCIAL
10 MEDIA PLATFORM AGAINST A USER IN RESPONSE TO THE USER POSTING
11 CONTENT IN VIOLATION OF THE SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM'S POLICIES
12 CONCERNING THREATENING OR CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR. "ADVERSE ACTION"
13 INCLUDES A RESTRICTION, SUSPENSION, OR TERMINATION OF A USER'S
14 ACCOUNT ON A SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM."

15 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

16 Page 6, strike lines 6 through 26 and substitute:

17 "(2) NOT LATER THAN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS AFTER A SOCIAL
18 MEDIA PLATFORM TAKES AN ADVERSE ACTION AGAINST A USER, THE
19 OPERATOR OF THE SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM SHALL REPORT THE ADVERSE
20 ACTION TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, INCLUDING THE
21 CONTENT IN QUESTION THAT WAS ALLEGEDLY POSTED BY THE USER."

22 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.
